# Cup O' Joe

*Weekly Reflections* by Joseph Zenk, Pastoral Leader

I suspect we are all well aware that Pope Francis has designated this current year as a Jubilee Year of Mercy. But also recall that we don't have to go far for mercy to be shown. As our Lenten Project tried to show, there are possibilities for mercy to be lived out right here in our communities.

The best place for mercy to be shown? Within our families and marriages. That's where the daily lived out grind of life happens. And its right there that mercy needs to be met.

This past month I ran across an article from Our Sunday Visitor which talked about Mercy in the Home: The Corporal Works of Mommy and Daddy. I thought it was so good, I wanted to pass along some of what it said. The following comes from that article:

There is great spiritual truth in the idea that mercy is the essence of family life. It can be an incredible engine of spiritual growth. So here are ways you can draw spiritual significance from living out the simple tasks of life in your family:

**Feed the hungry** – Family members bless one another when they create a nurturing place around the dinner table for communion and conversation to occur.

**Give drink to the thirsty** – What parent hasn't been asked to get a thirsty child a drink in the middle of the night? Doing so cheerfully, with compassion, is a work of mercy.

**Clothe the naked** – Finding the grace to be patient while dealing with children who have only one idea of what their outfit should be can be an act of mercy.

**Sheltering the homeless** – Putting in the thought, time and effort it takes to make your house a welcoming home by working to make it beautiful yet hospitable reminds your children of their own dignity and the dignity of those who visit.

**Visit the sick** – When you respond to a sick child lovingly, refusing to treat them as an inconvenience, you are practicing mercy.

**Visit the imprisoned** – To banish our children to their rooms when they have committed some offense is one thing. But when we visit them a few minutes later to talk them through their error in a compassionate way, we live mercy.

**Bury the dead** – Helping a child deal with sad transitions in life requires incredible compassion and sensitivity.
