## Cup o' Joe

Weekly Reflections by Joseph Zenk, Parish Director

In our gospel this weekend, Jesus goes to the home of Simon Peter. Simon's mother-in-law was sick with a fever, so Jesus approached her, grasped her hand and immediately the fever left her. But that was only the beginning. Seeing this action, the disciples brought all in the area that were ill and gathered them at Simon's door. And many of those at the doorstep were cured.

This weekend we kick off our annual Bishop's Appeal drive, appropriately titled *Renewed in Christ*. It is only in Christ that we are renewed and made whole. It is only in Christ that we are cured of whatever it is that ails us and we are free to be who God created us to be. It is only in Christ that we are able to reach out to those at our doorstep and attempt to bring healing and hope to their lives.

As I've stated many times, I am a big proponent of the work of the Diocese of Green Bay. Rarely does a week go by that the diocese doesn't in some way – directly or indirectly – contribute to my ministry as parish director of our three parishes. And without a doubt, the work of the diocese directly touches the lives and work of the staff of our three parishes.

But the Bishop's Appeal is not about me or the staff, but rather it is about the lives that are touched through the efforts of many. It is about the students who are raised in discipleship within Divine Savior School and our Religious Education programs. It is about the adults who are ministered to through mornings of reflection. It is about lives that are allowed to begin again – whether through the work of Catholic Charities or the Marriage Tribunal. It is about those lay ministers and deacons who are formed in ministry to help lead communities to be renewed in Christ. In short, the dollars we give touch the lives of so many individuals – both throughout our diocese and right here within our three parishes of Holy Rosary, Ss Peter & Paul and St. Ann.

At the end of today's Gospel, Jesus urges the disciples to move on from the comfort and security of Capernaum. Peter goes to Jesus and lets him know that everyone is looking for him. But Jesus replies "Let us go on to the nearby villages that I may preach there also. For this purpose have I come." The Gospel is called to be preached to the larger church, not just the one close by. I hope you prayerfully consider a gift to the 2012 Bishop's Appeal campaign as one way of us continuing in that tradition.
