- **Growth in our individual prayer and community prayer**
- **Sharing Time, Talent, and Treasure in the parish and community**

As a parent, at your child’s Baptism, you were asked: “It will be your duty to bring your child up to keep God’s commandments as Christ taught us, by loving God and our neighbor. Do you clearly understand what you are undertaking?” You said, “Yes!”

Your Baptismal commitment to your child would include such involvement and support of Catholic Religious Education at home and in the parish by:

- **Completing Twice a Month Catholic Mass Worksheets and discussing the homily as a family weekly**
- **Attendance at parent/family events**
- **Completion of Religious Education Assignments**
- **Help your student learn their Traditional Catholic Prayers**
- **Support of charitable efforts in the parish and the community**

In keeping with a Christian Stewardship Way of Life:

1. A child/youth will be accepted into the Religious Education Program if he/she is part of a family who is an active parishioner of Holy Rosary Parish or another Catholic parish.

2. The parish will continue to strive to provide Catholic resources to assist parents in their own growth in the Catholic faith to grow into a household of faith.
