Sue is looking into grant funding to help defer cost of the Diocesan Census program.

It was suggested to offer Parishioners a chance to purchase the old church marble. We will work on finding a fair price and offer it for sale to those interested.

Building & Grounds update:

- Roof over the kitchen area is in dire need of replacement as repairs will no longer hold up

Deacon Pat now is set up with a desk/workspace in the office at Holy Rosary.
